### Wednesday, May 25, 2016 :

Teachers :they can have lunch at a typical local Sicilian cuisine " Don Ciccio " near to Villa Palagonia or anywhere they want.

Afternoon : 15:00 appointment at the roundabout of "The BAGH " the little trade center near ITET " Sturzo " .

15:30 departure by coach .

First stop to visit the former Sant'Erasmo depot of railways Locomotives that is now a cultural center for exhibitions. Guided tour EUR 4 per person (interesting for action 2) and the seat of RAI-3 one of the three Italian national television networks( interesting for Action 4 as one of the " places of power " ) . **Monday, May 30 :**

**Bagheria - Modica- Siracusa** 7:00 departure by coaches from the roundabout of THE BAGH near the ITET " Sturzo " of Bagheria and arrival in Modica at about 11:00



Modica is divided into two parts: Upper Modica and Lower Modica. It is one of the most fascinating parts of southern Sicily, known not only for its baroque treasures, but also for its fine chocolate. Arrival in Lower Modica. Here we'll want to park and walk along Corso Umberto I, the main street of the old town. The main monuments of Modica Bassa are: the Cathedral of St. Peter, on Corso Umberto, the Cathedral of the Carmine, in Piazza Matteotti and the Piccolo Teatro Garibaldi, always in Corso Umberto I. But it is at the top that we find the more prestigious baroque buildings , including the Church of St. George (Corso San Giorgio), extraordinary masterpiece by Rosario Gagliardi, and the Church of San Giovanni Evangelista (near Piazza San Giovanni), another magnificent example of Baroque church with staircase. To achieve them we must sweat a bit '. We expect it to face a steep uphill walk. We recommend, in fact, comfortable shoes during the tour.

11.30: To repay the effort and recuperate will taste the famous chocolate of Modica. One of the best places to sample it is the Ancient Dolceria Bonajuto (Corso Umberto I, 159) where students will be shown the production practices of the company before tasting. This company produces chocolate since 1880 and now as then, it is all done by hand according to traditional recipes. At Dolceria Bonajuto you can delight not only with chocolate in various flavors, but with other specialties including mpanatigghi, cannoli, the nucatoli, white nougat and more.

This visit will allow our students of the 'Action 3 to touch the business practices and know the techniques of local production. The visit will be made with a guide in English and Italian at a cost of € 3 per person.

3:00 HOURS: Lunch .....

15:00: We'll continue our journey From Modica towards Syracuse but along the way you meet Cassibile with its museum of the armistice so if possible we will stop to visit it.

18:00: Arrival at the archaeological park in Syracuse to visit the park and to assist (optional) the representation of the greek tragedy Alcestis (price ranging from 30 to 75 Euros)

Ore 21:00 return for room accommodation at HOTEL SCALA GREEK Syracuse (price room for one night with breakfast included: 25 € per person approximately).

You can have dinner outside or at the hotel (not included) and overnight.

### **Tuesday, May 31:**

**Siracusa:** Morning: 900 hours visit of Ortigia, walk in the District of Giudecca (the old Jewish quarter of Siracusa), Cathedral Square, 12:00: Visit of the air raid shelters (**Interesting for Action 1**) time to be confirmed on the basis of reservation that we will be given. Cost: Tickets: € 5.00 - Reduced ticket: € 2.50.

**Please come equipped with lists pupils on letterhead of their schools to have reductions on the tickets)**

Ortigia, the historic center of Syracuse, is an island connected to the mainland by a couple of bridges. In this area, easily explored on foot we will visit the quarter of Giudecca and air raid shelters used during The Second World War II and of particular interest to our students of the **action 1**. The area is characterized by an intricate network of narrow streets: here are the main monuments and places of tourist interest in the city, as well as numerous cafes, taverns and restaurants.

Beautiful and elegant squares, among which Piazza Duomo, a masterpiece of Baroque urban planning and certainly one of the most spectacular places in the whole Sicily Sicily.

Cathedral Square is the central square of Syracuse, meeting place and outdoor seating area onto which, in addition to the cathedral, magnificent baroque palaces richly decorated: the Municipal Palace, the Archbishop's Palace, Palazzo Beneventano del Bosco and the Church of St. Lucia to the Abbey, dedicated to Saint Lucia, the patron saint of the city.

Visit at the Archaeological Park,



The site boasts the most beautiful ruins of the classical era of Syracuse. It was here in Neapolis, one of the five districts in which the ancient city was divided, the civil and religious buildings of greater importance were here. The most famous was and still is the great Greek Theatre, dating from the fifth century BC One of the best preserved Greek theaters, the largest of Sicily and, every year in the months of May and June, it is the scene of a series of classical plays, Greek tragedies that attract thousands of spectators from all parts of Sicily, and especially an event expected in the island as well as being a shining example of industrial upgrading is not a relic of the territory but with an entrepreneurial as an object of study for students of **Action 3** of our partnership.

13-00-14.00 lunch .

**Afternoon:** Siracusa-Catania Historical Museum of the landing of 1943 (interesting for **Action 2**, since the museum is an ex-lab processing sulfur where you can see various artifacts of the landing in Sicily and there will be a simulation of bombardment) cost € 2 per student.
